

BEACONSFIELD SCHOOL (2114)

Proposed Enrolment Scheme

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting from the intersection of Scotts Road and Pareora River Road

- North West along Pareora River Road to Brasell Road
- North East along Brasell Road (across the Pareora River) to Summerleaze Road
- South East along Summerleaze Road to Munro Road
- South East along Munro Road to the Timaru – Pareora Highway (SH 1)
- North East along the Timaru – Pareora Highway (SH 1) to Campbell Road
 - Including all addresses on Campbell Road
- South East (across country) to the coastline
- North along the coastline to Ellis Road
- North West along Ellis Road to the Timaru – Pareora Highway (SH 1) / Talbot Road intersection
 - Including addresses on the Timaru – Pareora Highway (SH 1) between Ellis Road and Scarborough Road
- West along Talbot Road to Salisbury Road
- North along Salisbury Road to Beaconsfield Road
 - Including Beaconsfield Road between Salisbury Road and Rocky Hundreds Road
- South along Beaconsfield Road to Beaconsfield Flat Road
 - Including Adair Road between Beaconsfield Road and Sutton Road
- North West along Beaconsfield Flat Road to Guscott Road
 - Including Bath Street
 - Including Pudjeck Road between Beaconsfield Flat Road and Adair Road, including Doyle Road and Adair Settlement Road
 - Including George Ward Road between Beaconsfield Flat Road and Adair Road
- North along Guscott Road to Holme Station Road
 - Including Holme Station Road between Guscott Road and Adair Road
- West along Holme Station Road to Pareora River Road
 - Including Claremount Bush Road and Purves Road
- North West along Pareora River Road to Craigmore Valley Road
 - Including addresses at the Pareora Reserve
 - Including Pareora River Road up to Evans Crossing Road
 - Including Evans Crossing Road to the Pareora River
 - Including Pareora Gorge Road up to address 177 Pareora Gorge Road
- South West along Craigmore Valley Road to the Timunga Road / Middle Yards Road intersection
 - Including Craigmore Hill Road
 - Including Timunga Road between Craigmore Valley Road and Elders Road
- South West along Middle Yards Road to Back Line Road
 - Including Back Line Road between Middle Yards Road and Elders Road
- South along Back Line Road to Blue Cliffs Road
 - Including Government Track
- North East along Blue Cliffs Road to Davisons Road (also called Cocks Cutting Road)
- West, then North along Davisons Road to Andersons Road
- East along Andersons Road to Cairds Road
 - Including Cairds Road between Andersons Road and Lyalldale Middle Road
- North East along Cairds Road to Pleasant Valley Road
- East along Pleasant Valley Road to Pareora River Road
- North West along Pareora River Road to Scotts Road

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the order of priority specified in the Education and Training Act 2020.

One calendar month before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period subsequent to the first, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
