

CHISNALLWOOD INTERMEDIATE (3314)

Proposed Enrolment Scheme

(Updated to Education and Training Act 2020)

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting from the intersection of Marshland Road and Mairehau Road;

- East along the south side only of Mairehau Road to Concord Place
 - Including all addresses on Concord Place
 - Including 205 Mairehau Road
- East along Mairehau Road to Burwood Road
- North along Burwood Road to Waitikiri Drive
 - Including addresses on Cameo Grove up to number 12 Cameo Grove
 - Including all addressees on Suntory Lane, Araucana Way, Minorca Lane, Serama Place and Nederland Avenue
- North along Waitikiri Drive to the end of the road
 - Including all addresses on Alpine View Lane, John Morel Place, Timbers Lane, Len Hale Place,
 - **NOTE: consultation will inform the inclusion / exclusion of:**
 - **Bluestone Drive, Waitikiri Square, West Green, Millpond Place, Rockport Place, Old Mill Lane, Lakebridge Place, Timberlands Terrace,**
- South east across Bottle Lake Forest Park from the end of Waitikiri Drive to 19 Ruahine Place
- North east to the end of Ruahine Place
 - Including all addresses on Ruahine Place
- South across the road reserve to the intersection of Rothesay Road and Puhara Avenue
- South west along Puhara Avenue to Putake Drive
 - Including addresses on Kohi Drive up to address number 16
- South along Putake Drive to Mairehau Road
- West along Mairehau Road to the eastern boundary of 296A Mairehau Road – the western side of Travis Wetland
- South, then east along the western boundary of Travis Wetland around to the intersection of Travis Country Drive and Travis Road (SH 74)
- East along Travis Road (SH 74) to Anzac Drive (SH 74)
- South along Anzac Drive (SH 74) and across the Ōtākaro / Avon river
- East along the southern bank of the Ōtākaro / Avon river to the Wainoni Road Bridge
- South west along Wainoni Road to Shortland Street
- South east along Shortland Street to Pages Road
 - Including 273 Pages Road
- South west along Pages Road to Woodham Road
- West along Woodham Road to Kerrs Road
- North along Kerrs Road to the intersection with Avonside Drive, then north to the southern bank of the Ōtākaro/Avon River
- North east along the river around to the Avondale Bridge and the intersection with New Brighton Road
- West along New Brighton Road to Kingsford Street
- North along Kingsford Street to Broomfield Terrace
- North west along Broomfield Terrace to Horseshoe Lake Road
- North along Horseshoe Lake Road to Lake Terrace Road
- West along Lake Terrace Road to Marshland Road
- North along the eastern side only of Marshland Road to Mairehau Road.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the [following order of priority](#):

1. **First priority** is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
2. **Second priority** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
3. **Third priority** must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
4. **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is the child of a former student of the school.
5. **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board or a child of a member of the school's board.
6. **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

Before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with [instructions by the Secretary](#), under [Schedule 20, Clause 3 \(1\)](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of address or sibling relationship.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
