Cotswold Mātāhae School (3324) Proposed Enrolment Scheme

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Note that eligibility to enrol is based on the below written description of the home zone. Any associated maps are a visual representation of this description.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Starting from the intersection of Watsons Road and Harewood Road;

- North east along Watsons Road to Waimakariri Road
- North east along the east side only of Waimakariri Road to Sawyers Arms Road
- North west along Sawyers Arms Road to Johns Road (SH 1)
- North east along the east side only of Johns Road (SH 1) to Gardiners Road
- South along Gardiners Road to Haddon Lane
- East along Haddon Lane to the western boundary of Willowbank Wildlife Reserve
- East along the southern boundary of Willowbank Wildlife Reserve to the eastern boundary of the reserve
- Due south east to the Styx River and south western boundary of Styx Mill Reserve
- East along the southern bank of Styx River to a point that aligns with the intersection of Styx Mill Road and Highsted Road
- Due south along the west side only to the intersection of Styx Mill Road and Highstead Road
- South along Highsted Road to Redbrook Road
- East along Redbrook Road to the eastern boundary of 33 Redbrook Road
 - o Including addresses on Redbrook Road between Highsted Road and Newbury Lane
 - Including addresses on Oakmill Drive between Redbrook Road and Millstead Lane (inclusive of address 19, 21 and 28 Oakmill Drive)
 - Including all addresses on Millstead Lane
 - Including all addresses on Newbury Lane
- Due south from the boundary of 33 Redbrook Road to the southern boundary of the retirement village
- Due west from the southern boundary of the retirement village to 214 Highsted Road
- South west along Highsted Road to Glenmore Avenue
- East along Glenmore Avenue to Brockham Street
 - Including addresses on Mendip Place and Cintra Place
 - Including addresses on Glenmore Avenue between Brockham Street and Grampian Street
- South along Brockham Street to Veitches Road
- West along Veitches Road to Sawyers Arms Road
 - Including all addresses on 74 Veitches Road
- North west along Sawyers Arms Road to Highsted Road
 - o Including address 233 Sawyers Arms Road
- South west along Highsted Road to Harewood Road

- Including addresses on Drysdale Street between Highsted Road and Reynolds Avenue
- o Including addresses on Reynolds Avenue between Drysdale Street and Ian Place
- o Including all addresses on Ian Place
- Including Bainton Street between Highsted Road and Rolfe Place
- Including Rolfe Place
- North West along Harewood Road to Watsons Road

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

- 1. **First priority** is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
- 2. **Second priority** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- 3. **Third priority** must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- 4. **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is the child of a former student of the school.
- 5. **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board or a child of a member of the school's board.
- 6. **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

Before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with <u>instructions by the Secretary</u>, under <u>Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1)</u> of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
