Amendment of Enrolment Scheme


Overview – what is changing?

Queenstown's newest school, Te Kura Whakatipu o Kawarau is set to open in Term 1, 2022. The Ministry of Education will establish a new enrolment scheme for this school and will also need to amend the existing enrolment scheme for Remarkables Primary School.

The Ministry is proposing to amend the Remarkables Primary School home zone by removing the area south of the Kawarau River and Peninsula Road. This is shown on the map below or [here](#). This means that:

- Hanley's Farm, Jack's Point and the Coneburn development area will be **removed** from the Remarkables Primary School zone and become part of the new enrolment scheme for Te Kura Whakatipu o Kawarau
- Kelvin Heights and properties along Peninsula Road, back to the intersection with SH6, will **remain** in the Remarkables Primary School enrolment scheme home zone.
- Frankton, Frankton Flats and Five Mile area will **remain** in the Remarkables Primary School enrolment scheme home zone, with minor amendments made to include Frankton Road properties from the BP roundabout west to the Z service station (see attached map).

The Ministry is also considering including a transitional arrangement to minimise the impact for current families. This is a new process included in the Education and Training Act 2020 and will allow siblings of current students to retain the right to enrol at Remarkables Primary School in the future, provided certain criteria are met.




What does this mean for my family?

Any student currently enrolled at Remarkables Primary School will not be impacted by a change to the enrolment scheme. All students enrolled (and have started attending) will be entitled to continue attending Remarkables Primary School, irrespective of where they currently live.

The change to the home zone will affect all enrolments starting in 2022. It is important to note that enrolment starts when you first attend school, not when enrolment forms are completed. This means the changes will include current families who have a younger sibling looking to enrol at Remarkables Primary School, and will start school in 2022 or later. The flowchart below will help you assess your indicative eligibility to enrol from 2022. There are also scenarios available to view [here](#) that show how this works in practice. Please note that if agreed, this grandparenting agreement will replace previous transitional arrangements developed in 2012.

An in zone enrolment is automatically entitled to enrol at the school. An out of zone enrolment is not guaranteed a place at the school and you will need to apply through the school's out of zone processes **if** there are spaces available.



Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes and new enrolment schemes. You can have your say by:

Consultation will run until the end of Term 1 – Friday 16 April. The Ministry will consider all feedback and liaise with the Remarkables Primary School Board before making a final decision. We expect the School community to be updated about progress made mid-Term 2. The new schemes and changes will come into effect for the beginning of 2022.
