

The Terrace School (Alexandra) (3844)

Enrolment Scheme

Effective from DD/MM/YYYY

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone takes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Airport Road and Clyde-Alexandra Road (SH 8), the home zone follows:

- South-east on Clyde-Alexandra Road (SH 8) until Boundary Road
 - Including Henderson Drive and all the side streets off of it
- South-east on the northern side of Centennial Avenue (SH 8) until Killarney Street
 - including Boundary Road and all the side streets off of it,
 - and including Beresford Street
- East on the northern side of Killarney Street until Talbert Street (SH 85)
- North on the western side of Talbert Street (SH 85) until Little Valley Road
- North-east on Talbert Street (SH 85) until Manuherikia Road (SH 85)
 - including Rawhiti Street,
 - including Rapuke Street,
 - and including Samson Street
- North-east on Manuherikia Road (SH 85) until Galloway Road
- North-east on Galloway Road until Crawford Hills Road
 - including Govan Road,
 - and including Lower Manorburn Dam Road
- East on Crawford Hills Road up to and including 464 Crawford Hills Road
- West back along Crawford Hills Road until Tiger Hill Road
- North on Tiger Hill Road until the end of Tiger Hill Road
- From the end of Tiger Hill Road jumps to the north-west to Chatto Creek-Springvale Road (SH 85), online with 1180 Chatto Creek-Springvale Road (SH 85)
- South-west on Chatto Creek-Springvale Road (SH 85) until Brassknocker Road
- North-east on Brassknocker Road until Nelsen Ridge Road
- South on Nelsen Ridge Road until Provincial Lane
 - including Nelsen Ridge Road to the north of Brassknocker Road,
 - including all the side streets off of Nelsen Ridge Road until Provincial Lane,
 - and including Provincial Lane
- North back along Nelsen Ridge Road and then Brassknocker Road until Chatto Creek-Springvale Road (SH 85)

- South-west on Chatto Creek-Springvale Road (SH 85) until Springvale Road
- West on Springvale Road until Kelliher Lane
- South-east on Kelliher Lane until Manuherikia Road (SH 85)
- South on Manuherikia Road (SH 85) until Letts Gully Road
 - including Roc View Road,
 - including O'Neill Lane,
 - and including Ferris Road
- North-west on Letts Gully Road up to and including number 334 Letts Gully Road
- From 334 Letts Gully Road jumps south-west to the end of Hillview Road
- From the end of Hillview Road travels south-east on Hillview Road until Dunstan Road
- North-west on Dunstan Road until Coates Road
 - including Waldron Road
- South-east back along Dunstan Road until Chicago Street
- South-west on Chicago Street until Russel Street
- North-west on Russel Street until Enterprise Street
 - including Russel Street to the north of Enterprise Street
- South-west on Enterprise Street until Royal Terrace
 - including Marslin Street
- West on Royal Terrace until Centennial Avenue
 - including Gregg Street.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority

This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.

Second Priority

will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority

will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority

will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority

will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority

will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
