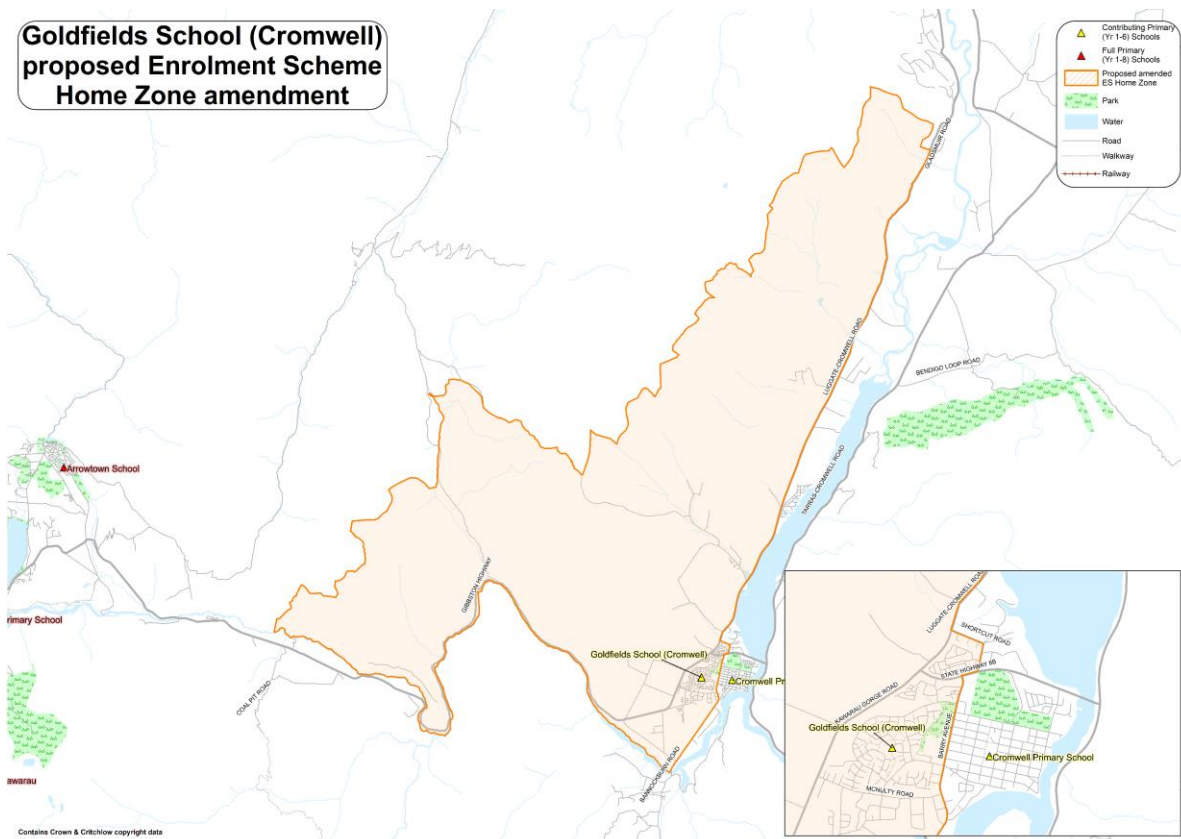
Amendment of Enrolment Scheme

Overview – what is changing?

The Ministry of Education is proposing to amend the existing enrolment scheme for Goldfields School and at the same time will be amending the enrolment scheme for Cromwell Primary School.

The Ministry is proposing to amend the Goldfields School home zone to reflect the need to slightly rebalance the home zones between the primary schools in Cromwell. The amendment will also update the schemes to the most recent land parcel and address point information and will update the written descriptions of the Cromwell Primary School and Goldfields School home zones. The proposed scheme and full written description can be found [here](#). Changes include:

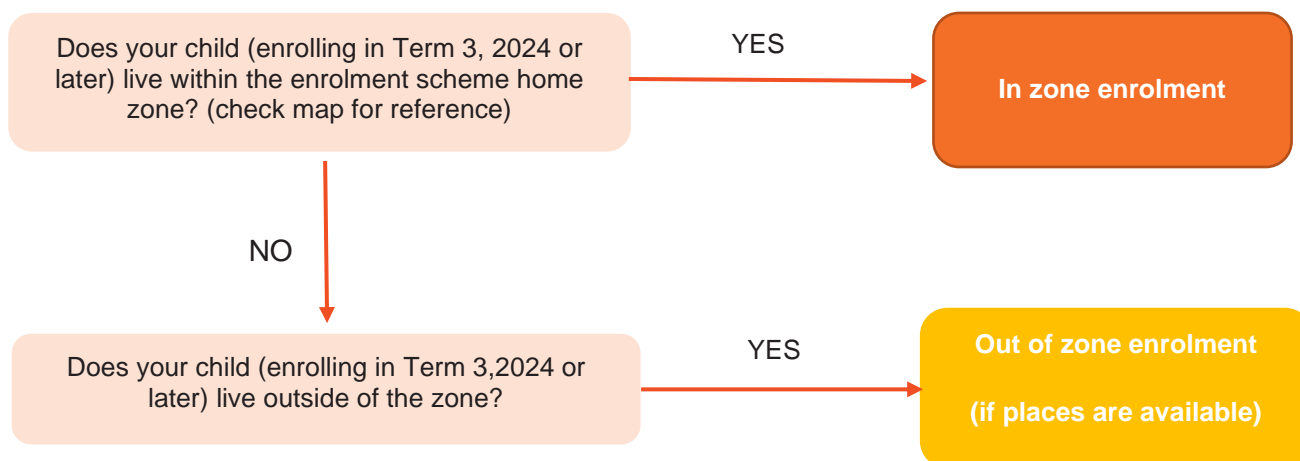
- Wooing Tree area is to become part of the Goldfields School home zone and is removed from Cromwell Primary School zone. The Wooing Tree area is defined as being bounded by the southern and western side of Shortcut Road, Luggate-Cromwell Road, and State Highway 8B.
- The end of the boundary at 3207 Gibbston Highway is redrawn to the northern bank of the Kawarau River to reflect both sides of the highway are included.
- The boundary at 2437 Luggate-Cromwell Road is redrawn to accurately reflect that this is the end of zone.



What does this mean for my family?

Any student currently enrolled at Goldfields School will not be impacted by the new enrolment scheme. All students enrolled (and attending school) will be entitled to continue attending Goldfields School, irrespective of where they currently live.

The change to the home zone will affect all enrolments starting in Term 3, 2024. This includes current families who have a younger sibling looking to enrol at Goldfields School and starting in Term 3, 2024 or later. The flowchart below will help you assess your indicative eligibility to enrol from mid-2024.



Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes and new enrolment schemes. You can have your say by:

Consultation will run until Thursday 21 March 2024. The Ministry will consider all feedback and liaise with the Goldfields School Board before making a final decision. We expect the school community to be updated about the approved scheme at the end of Term 2. The new scheme and changes will come into effect for Term 3, 2024 enrolments.
