




Heriot School New Enrolment Scheme

Overview - what is changing?

The Ministry of Education regularly monitors enrolment patterns, population growth and anticipated school roll changes across the wider Clutha District/Hokonui Rūnaka area. As part of this monitoring and regular review, we now consider an enrolment scheme is necessary for Heriot School. This is due to growth of the school roll and because we need to ensure the Board has a fair and transparent mechanism to manage the roll. It also means we can ensure we are making best use of educational facilities across the wider Clutha District/Hokonui Rūnaka area.

The new enrolment scheme will have a home zone, like other schools with enrolment schemes in the area. Children that live within this area will have entitlement to enrol at Heriot School. The home zone area is shown on the map below and includes:


- North west along Paradise Flat Road along the eastern bank of the Pomahaka River until it meets the end of Hukarere Station Road
- East along Wilden School Road until its intersection with Moa Flat Road
- And south along Fleming Road until Black Gully Road West



What does this mean for my family?

Any student currently enrolled at Heriot School will not be impacted by the new enrolment scheme. All students enrolled (and attending school) will be entitled to continue attending Heriot School, irrespective of where they currently live.

The change to the home zone will affect all enrolments starting in 2023. This includes current families who have a younger sibling looking to enrol at Heriot School and starting in 2023 or later. The flowchart below will help you assess your indicative eligibility to enrol from 2023.



Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes and new enrolment schemes. You can have your say by:

Consultation will run until Wednesday 28 September 2022. The Ministry will consider all feedback and liaise with the Heriot School Board before making a final decision. We expect the school community to be updated about the approved scheme in Term 4. The new scheme and changes will come into effect for 2023 enrolments.
