

# HINDS SCHOOL (3375)

## Proposed Enrolment Scheme

### Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting from the intersection of Hinds Highway (SH 1) and Windermere Road

- South East along Windermere Road to Boundary Road
- South West along Boundary Road to Hinds River Road
- South along Hinds River Road to Surveyors Road
- West along Surveyors Road to the Hinds River
- South East along the South West bank of the Hinds River to the coastline
- South West along the coastline to the Rangitata River
- North West along the North bank of the Rangitata River to the Rangitata Highway (SH 1)
- North East along the Rangitata Highway (SH 1) to Withells Road
- North West along Withells Road to Maronan Ealing Road
- North East along Maronan Ealing Road to Maronan Road
- East along Maronan Road to Lovetts Road
  - Including Maronan Valetta Road up to address #64
  - Including Barford Road between Maronan Road and Siberia Road
- South along Lovetts Road to Hinds Highway (SH 1)
- South West along the North side only of Hinds Highway (SH 1) to Windermere Road

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

### Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

### Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the order of priority specified in the Education and Training Act 2020.

One calendar month before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period subsequent to the first, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act

2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
