

# **KARETU SCHOOL (1031)**

## **Proposed Draft Enrolment Scheme**

Effective from **Day Month Year**

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

### **Home Zone**

**All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.**

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description, and all no-exit roads off the boundary roads are included in the zone unless otherwise stated.

The zone starts at number 2195 Waikare Road and travels south and then west along Waikare Road to include all addresses on Waihaha Road; Whaakaurau Valley Road; Kura Road; and Owae Road from the intersection with Waikare Road up to number 495 Owae Road. The zone includes all addresses to the north of Waikare Road (Waikino Road; Ranui Road; and Piwakawaka Rise). The zone continues to travel west along Waikare Road from the Owae Road intersection to include all addresses on Pakaru Road; Doels Road; and Tirohunga Road. The zone travels to the Waikare Road/Doels Road/Paihia Road (State Highway 11) intersection and then travels south along Paihia Road (State Highway 11) to include addresses along the east side of Paihia Road (State Highway 11) from numbers 250 to 348 inclusive.

### **Additional Entitlement to Enrol (Grandparenting)**

- This provision has been approved for inclusion in the Karetu School enrolment scheme under Section 75 1(b) of the Education and Training Act 2020. For families of currently enrolled students whose addresses become out of zone as a result of the implementation of this Enrolment Scheme.

**Section 75 of the Education and Training Act 2020** states that;

“the Secretary may authorise an enrolment scheme to permit a student to enrol at the school as if the student lived in the home zone of the school if, -

- (b) in the case of a new enrolment scheme, the student;
1. lives outside of the home zone of the new enrolment scheme; and
  2. has a sibling who is enrolled at the school at the time that the new enrolment scheme is implemented.”

If applying for enrolment under this part of the Enrolment Scheme, the sibling's name and evidence of a sibling relationship may be required by the school.

[Section 75](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020 sets out the definition of a “sibling” for these purposes.

The school will maintain a list of students enrolled at the time of the implementation of the enrolment scheme by the school's board in order to enable determination of eligibility to enrol under this provision.

### **Special Programmes**

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

### **Out of Zone Enrolments**

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.


Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

| <b><u>First Priority</u></b>  | This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.       |
| <b><u>Second Priority</u></b> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.   |
| <b><u>Third Priority</u></b>  | will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.  |
| <b><u>Fourth Priority</u></b> | will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.  |
| <b><u>Fifth Priority</u></b>  | will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school. |
| <b><u>Sixth Priority</u></b>  | will be given to all other applicants.  |

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

**Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.**
