

Lakeview School Enrolment Scheme

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school. (All numbers are inclusive).

Starting on the Northern edge the scheme runs from the point on the boundary between the Wellington-Manawatu Districts that is Northwest of where Whangaehu Valley Road and Dreyers Rock Road intersect (North of the boundary between 421 & 649 Dreyers Rock Road). From there the scheme follows the Wellington-Manawatu District Boundary East until the Mangarei Road and Wairiri Road intersect. Properties on Daggs Road that are on the Wellington side of the Wellington-Manawatu District Boundary are in zone, the rest of Daggs Road is not in zone, Wairiri Road & Mangarei Road are in zone. All addresses on Te Ore Ore-Bideford Road and all roads off it are in zone. Addresses 20 – 1837 Whangaehu Valley Road are in zone. Ditton Road, Grahams Road and Clelands Road are in zone. The scheme continues Eastward along the Wellington-Manawatu District Boundary until north of the northern end of Tauweru River from there it goes east to the Whareama River and then south to the east end of Maringi Road (All addresses on Maringi Road are in zone) and then south-east to the west most end of Springhill Road (no addresses on Springhill Road are in zone) from there it continues directly south down to Mangapurupuru Road.

The scheme continues South-west from Mangapurupuru Road crossing over Mt Clyde Road and ending at the intersection of Masterton Castlepoint Road and Masterton Stronvar Road. From here the scheme moves south-west again along Watsons and Morris Roads towards the Ruamahanga River. Masterton Stronvar Road is not in zone. All addresses on Watson and Morris Road in zone. Then the scheme follows along the Ruamahanga River to River Road. All addresses on River Road are in zone. All addresses on Caves Road are in zone. 37- 231 Masterton Castlepoint Road is in zone.

The scheme then runs Northwest to Chapel Street along Johnstone Road and then Worksop Road. However, all addresses on Johnstone Street and Worksop Road are not in zone. Clyde Street is in zone. Addresses 2-86 even and 1-87 odd Colombo Road are in zone. All addresses on Macara Street, Kirton Street, Miriam Street and Hessey Street are in zone. Addresses 2-92 even and 41-91 odd on Dixon Street are in zone and 2-276 even and 15-263 odd Queen Street are in zone. Renall Street is not in zone.

The scheme then runs northeast along Chapel Street until the Waipoua River. Addresses 1-123 odd Chapel Street are in zone. The following streets off Chapel Street are in zone, Jackson Street, Perry Street, addresses 2-18 even and 1-13 odd Lincoln Road and King Street.

The scheme then runs Northwest along Waipoua River up to the end of Mahunga Road and then runs East to Cashmere Oaks Drive & Opaki Meadows Lane. Oxford Street and Miro Street are in zone. Most addresses in the Cashmere Oaks Estate development are in zone except where stated, this includes addresses on Cashmere Oaks Drive (all in zone), Sir Herbert Hart Avenue (4-10 are not in zone), Coralie Place (all in zone), McDonald Way (all in zone) and Roger Renal Avenue (11-27 not in zone). Addresses 2- 94 even and 1- 87 odd Opaki Road is in zone. Addresses 4-12 on Opaki Meadows Lane are in zone. The scheme then runs northeast from Opaki Meadows Lane to the end of Gordon Street. The scheme then runs south to the Ruamahanga River and north along

Ruamahanga River to the end of Matapihi Road. All addresses on Matapihi Road are in zone. All addresses on Black Rock Road, Gordon Street, Ardsley Lane and Milford Downs are in zone.

The scheme finally runs from the northern end of Matapihi Road northeast towards and through the boundary of properties 421 & 649 on Dreyers Rock Road and finally directly north back to the boundary of the Wellington & Manawatu Districts. James Road is not in zone.

Where a property has two or more entrances on different streets, or where the actual address of a property is in dispute, only the rateable address as recognised by the local Council will be considered to determine if the property is in or out of zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the order of priority specified in the Education and Training Act 2020.

One calendar month before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period subsequent to the first, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.

Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority will be given to all other applicants.

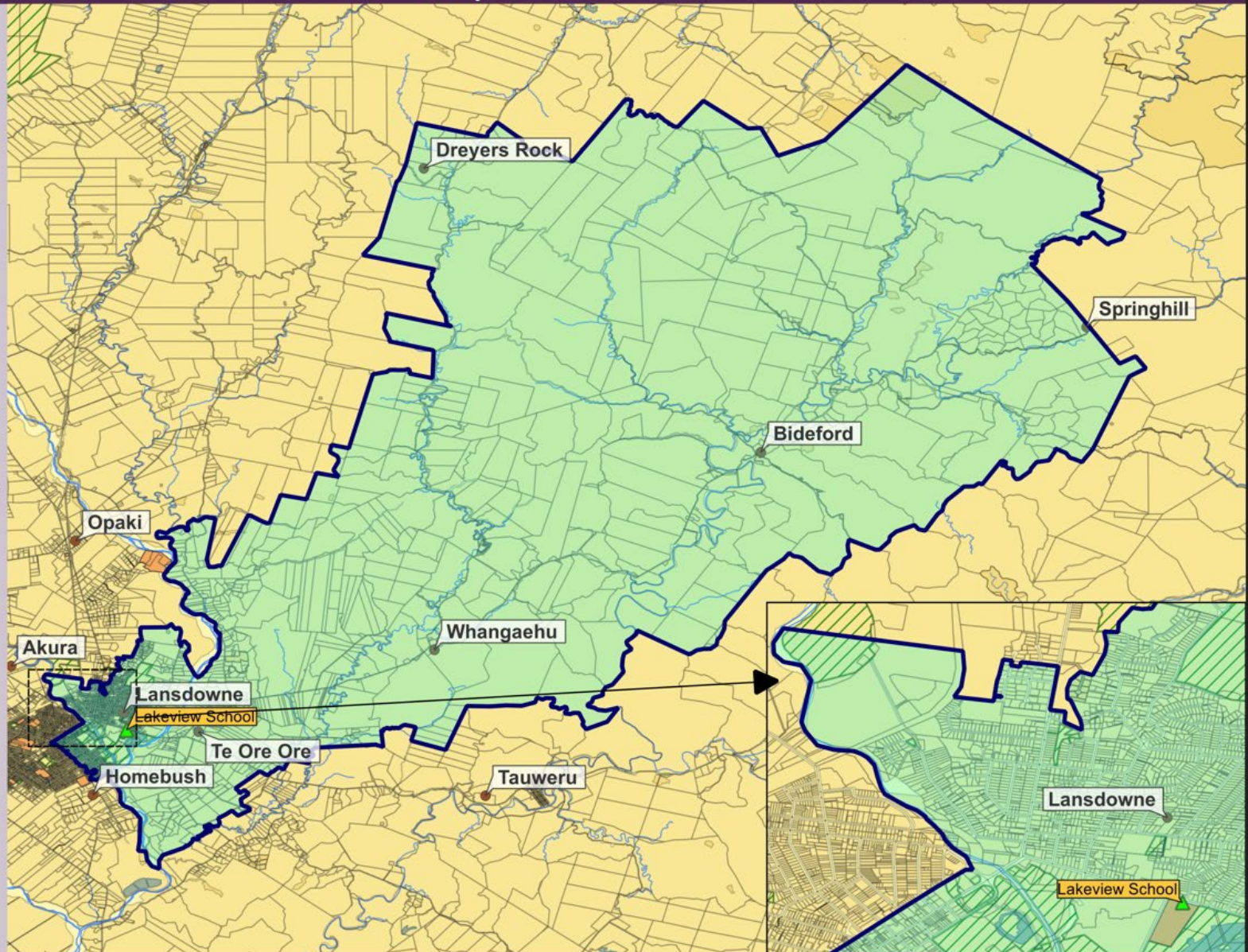
If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

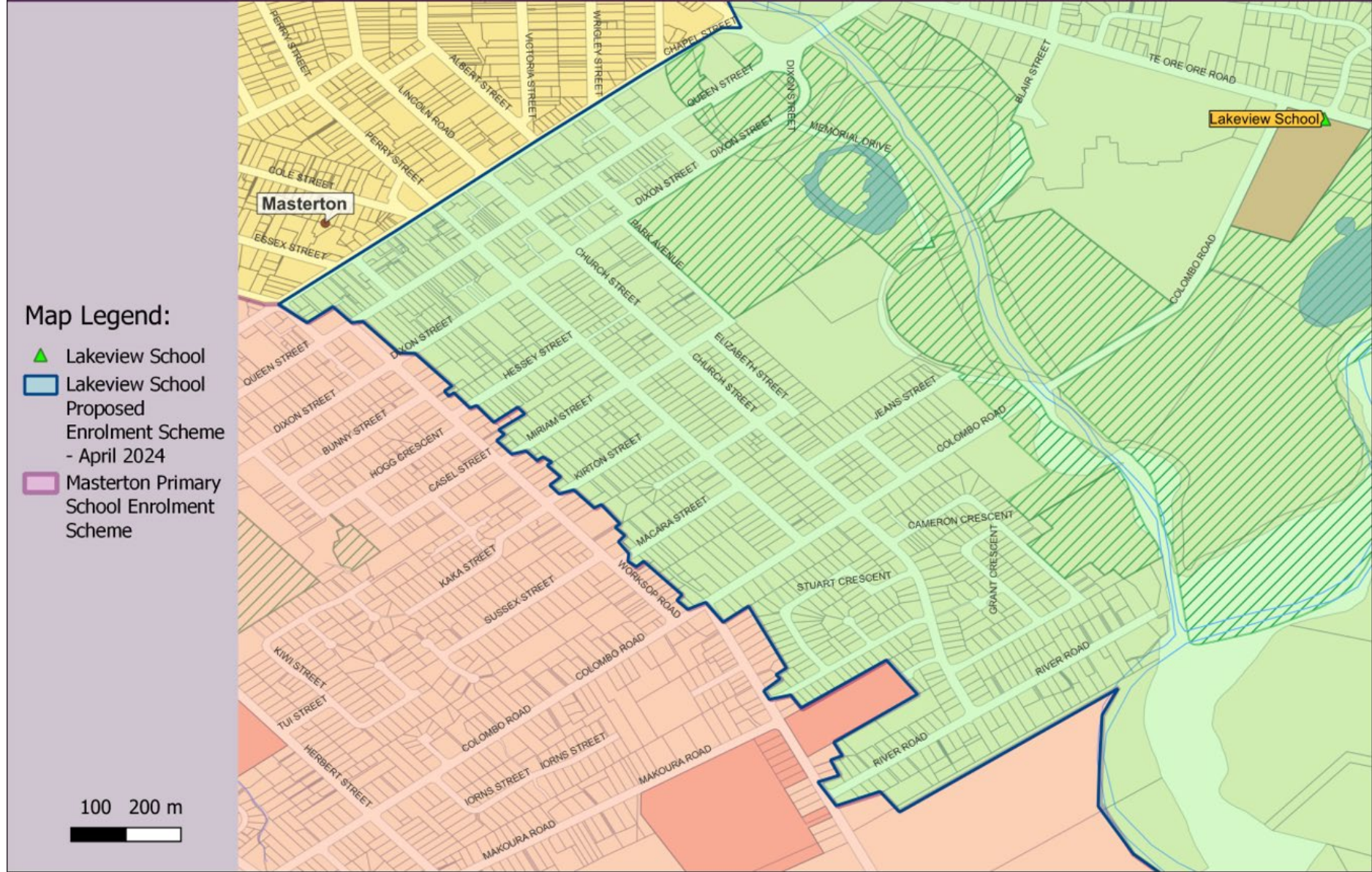
Lakeview School Proposed Enrolment Scheme - May 2024
