

Lincoln High School (#347)

Proposed Enrolment Scheme Amendment

Effective from 1 January 2022

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Addresses on both sides of the road are included unless otherwise stated.

From the outflow of the Selwyn-Waikirikiriri River into Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere

- North along the eastern bank of the Selwyn-Waikirikiriri River from Lake Ellesmere to Brookside & Burnham Road
- East along Brookside & Burnham Road to Corbetts Road
- North along Corbetts Road to Brookside Road
- North East along Brookside Road to Ellesmere Junction Road
- East along Ellesmere Junction Road to Selwyn Road
- North East along Selwyn Road to Dunns Crossing Road
- North East along the southern side only of Selwyn Road to Weedons Road
- North along the eastern side only of Weedons Road to the Christchurch Southern Motorway
- East along the southern side only of the Christchurch Southern Motorway to the Springs Road overbridge
- South along Springs Road to Marshs Road
 - Including John Paterson Drive
 - Including Busch Lane
- South East along Marshs Road to Whincops Road
- South along Whincops Road to Downies Road
- South East along Downies Road
- From the end of Downies Road to the intersection of Ellesmere Road and Trices Road
- South East along Trices Road to Sabys Road
- North East along Sabys Road to Candys Road
- South East along Candys Road to Halswell Road
- South along Halswell Road to Old Tai Tapu Road
- South East along Old Tai Tapu Road to Michaels Road
 - Including all properties accessed from Early Valley Road, Burkes Bush Road, Potters Lane, Holmes Road, and Rhodes Road)
- South along Michaels Road to Christchurch Akaroa Road (SH 75)
- South along Christchurch Akaroa Road (SH 75) to Gebbies Pass Road
 - Including all properties accessed from Ahuriri Road and Park Hill Road
- North along Gebbies Pass Road to Summit Road
- East along Summit Road to the end of the road, then East to the Packhorse Hut on the Te Ara Pātaka walkway
- East along the Te Ara Pātaka walkway (via Te Ahu Patiki / Mt Herbert) to Western Valley Road
- East along the Te Ara Pātaka walkway / Summit track to Mt Fitzgerald and the Fitzgerald Reserve
- Due South to the northern end of Whites Road
- South along Whites Road to Harmans Track
- East along Harmans Track to Christchurch Akaroa Road
 - Including Duddons Track
- South West along Christchurch Akaroa Road to French Peak Road
 - Including addresses on Christchurch Akaroa Road up to #5193
- South along French Peak Road to the end of the road
- South to the Eastern End of Okuti Valley Road

- West along Okuti Valley Road to Reynolds Valley Road
- South along Reynolds Valley Road to Bossu Road
- East along Bossu Road to Peraki Road
- South along Peraki Road to Peraki Bay
- West along the coastline to Birdlings Flat
- West along the coastline to the opening of Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere
- North across Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere to the outflow of the Selwyn-Waikirikiriri River.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Additional Entitlement to Enrol

This provision may be approved under Section 75 1 (a) of the Education and Training Act 2020.

For families of currently enrolled students whose addresses become out of zone as a result of the amendment to this Enrolment Scheme.

Section 75 of the Education and Training Act 2020 states that;

“the Secretary may authorise an enrolment scheme to permit a student to enrol at the school as if the student lived in the home zone of the school if, -

- (a) in the case of an existing enrolment scheme whose home zone is amended, —
- (i) the student lives outside the amended home zone; and
 - (ii) the student has a sibling who is enrolled at the school at the time that the amendment is implemented; and
 - (iii) the sibling, at the time that the amendment is implemented, lives inside the home zone as it was before the amendment; and
 - (iv) the student, at the time of enrolment, lives inside the home zone as it was before the amendment:

If applying for enrolment under this part of the Enrolment Scheme, the sibling’s name and evidence of a sibling relationship may be required by the school.

[Section 75](#) of the Education and Training Act 2020 sets out the definition of a “sibling” for these purposes.

The school will maintain a list of students enrolled at the time of the implementation of the enrolment scheme to enable determination of eligibility to enrol under this provision.

Note: That this is a very tightly defined concession. It would not apply to:

1. Children who move into the withdrawal area after the adoption of the enrolment scheme boundary amendment; or
2. Children of families/whānau who move out of the old zone after the adoption of the enrolment scheme boundary amendment.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the order of priority specified in the Education and Training Act 2020.

One calendar month before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period subsequent to the first, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:


- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.


If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

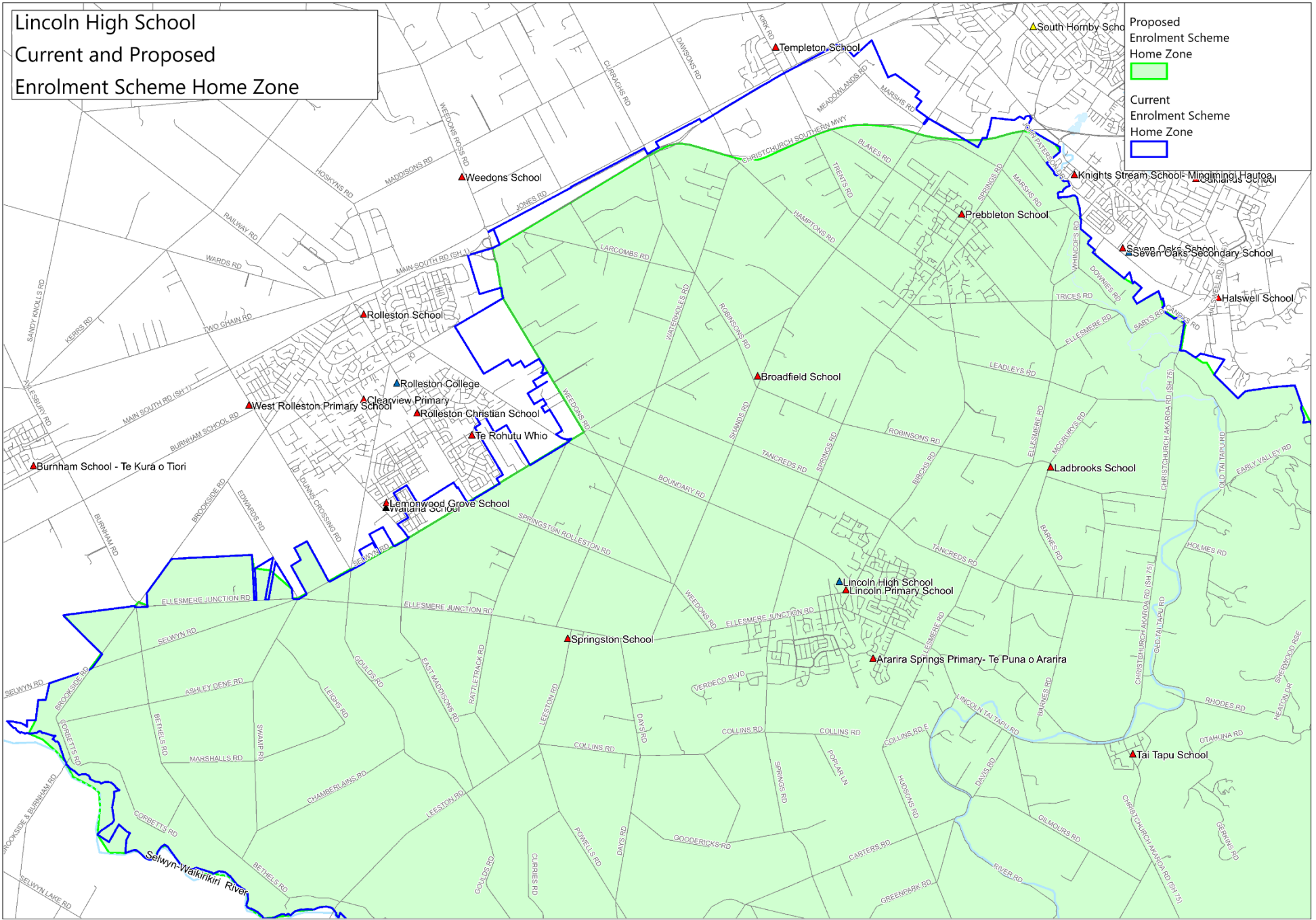
Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
