Amendment to Enrolment Scheme

Overview – what is happening?

The Ministry of Education is amending the enrolment scheme for Matua Primary School, which will be in effect for 1 January 2023. Having an enrolment scheme in place will ensure the Board of Trustees has a fair and transparent mechanism to manage the roll as it grows. Students that live within the amended home zone will have entitlement to enrol at Matua Primary School. The home zone description and map are shown below:

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

The enrolment zone boundary starts at the Matua Salt Marsh north-west of the railway line and behind 423 Ngatai Road. It then travels north-west to meet the shoreline on the Matua Peninsula.

The boundary then follows the coastline around the peninsular to include 1 Beach Road. It then travels south to meet the geographical line of the railway and then follows the railway west to 423 Ngatai Road.



What does this mean for my family?

If you live in the enrolment scheme home zone for Matua Primary School, you will be entitled to enrol your child at the school. This entitlement applies to new students starting school, as well as any primary school aged children currently attending another school in the area.

Families who live outside the enrolment scheme home zone of Matua Primary School do not have entitlement to enrol and could only attend if the Board of Trustees planned to enrol any out of zone students. The enrolment scheme will establish the process for this, and places will only be available if the Board of Trustees considers it has the capacity to allow for this. Further information about whether any out of zone places will be made available will be made later in 2022.

Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes to the enrolment scheme. You can have your say by:
