

## OPIKI SCHOOL (#2937)

### Proposed Amended Enrolment Scheme Description

#### Effective from:

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20 of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

#### Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below and shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school. Both sides of each road are included in the zone unless otherwise stated.

In a clockwise direction

1. The zone starts at the intersection of Te Awe Awe Road and Rangiotu Road and follows Rangiotu Road east to its intersection with Main Drain Road. Note: no addresses on Te Awe Awe Road are in-zone. 1083 Rangiotu Road is not in zone.
2. At the intersection of Rangiotu Road and Main Drain Road, the zone travels north on Main Drain Road to its intersection with Hoihere Road. 710 Main Drain Road and 379 Hoihere Road are in zone. 663 Main Drain Road is not in zone.
3. From the intersection of Main Drain Road and Hoihere Road, the zone returns south along Main Drain Road to its intersection with Rangiotu Road where it travels east on Rangiotu Road to its intersection with State Highway 56.
4. At the intersection of Rangiotu Road and State Highway 56, the zone continues east on State Highway 56 to its intersection with Hamiltons Line. 1658A and 1658B State Highway 56 are in zone. 1635 and 1685 State Highway 56 are not in zone.
5. From the intersection of State Highway 56 and Hamiltons Line, the zone travels south to the end of Hamiltons Line. All addresses numbered on Hamiltons Line are in zone.
6. At the end of Hamiltons Line, the zone travels overland following in zone land parcels to the eastern boundary of 167 Tane Road. No addresses on Te Puna Road are in zone.
7. From the eastern boundary of 167 Tane Road, the zone follows Tane Road west to its intersection with Opiki Road (SH56). 182 Tane Road is in zone. All addresses numbered on Humes Road are in zone.
8. At the intersection of Tane Road and Opiki Road (SH56), the zone follows Opiki Road (SH56) south to its intersection with Ashlea Road.
9. From the intersection of Opiki Road (SH56) and Ashlea Road, the zone follows Ashlea Road east to its intersection with Temukanui Road. 113 Ashlea Road is not in zone. No addresses on Temukanui Road are in zone.
10. At the intersection of Ashlea Road and Temukanui Road, the zone travels overland due south to the Linton Drain and follows the Linton Drain west to its confluence with the Tokomaru River. Only addresses on the northern side of the Linton Drain are in zone.

11. From its confluence with Linton Drain, the zone follows the Tokomaru River downstream until a point due east of the intersection of Opiki Road (SH56) and Ngui Road. Only addresses on the northern side of the Tokomaru River are in zone.
12. At a point on the Tokomaru River due east of the intersection of Opiki Road (SH56) and Ngui Road, the zone travels due west overland to that intersection. 147 Opiki Road (SH56) is in zone. 95 and 65 Opiki Road (SH56) are not in zone.
13. At the intersection of Opiki Road (SH56) and Ngui Road, the zone travels west on Ngui Road to its intersection with Okuku Road. All addresses numbered on Ngui Road are in zone. 212 and 213 Okuku Road are not in zone.
14. From the intersection of Ngui Road and Okuku Road, the zone travels west overland to the Manawatū River. 277 Okuku Road is in zone.
15. At a point on the Manawatū River due west of the intersection of Ngui Road and Okuku Road, the zone follows the Manawatū River upstream to its confluence with the Oroua River. Only addresses on the eastern side of the Manawatū River are in zone.
16. From the confluence of the Manawatū River and the Oroua River, the zone follows the Oroua River upstream to the Rangiotu Road Bridge. Only address on the eastern side of the Oroua River are in zone.
17. At the Rangiotu Road Bridge, the zone travels west on Rangiotu Road to the zone starting point at the intersection of Rangiotu Road and Te Awe Awe Road.

### **In-Zone Enrolments**

Proof of residence within the home zone may be required.

Each year applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published by notice in a media suitable for the local community. This will enable the school board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone. *(This paragraph is optional)*

### **Out of Zone Enrolments**

Each year the board will determine the number of places, and the number of pre-enrolment periods, which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The school board will publish this information by notice in a media suitable for the school and wider local community. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made, the date by which all applications must be received, and the date any ballot will be held.

Applications for enrolment for will be processed in the following order of priority, according to legislation:

| <b><u>First Priority</u></b>  | <i>This priority is not applicable to this school as it does not operate a special programme approved by the Secretary of Education.</i> |
| <b><u>Second Priority</u></b> | will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.  |
| <b><u>Third Priority</u></b>  | will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.   |

**Fourth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

**Fifth Priority** will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

**Sixth Priority** will be given to all other applicants.

Note: Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Schedule 20, Clause 3 of the Education and Training Act 2020.
