



Pillans Point School

Minor Amendment to Enrolment Scheme

Overview – what is happening?

The Ministry of Education is amending the enrolment scheme for Pillans Point School, which will be in effect for 1 January 2023. Having an enrolment scheme in place will ensure the Board of Trustees has a fair and transparent mechanism to manage the roll as it grows. Students that live within the amended home zone will have entitlement to enrol at Pillans Point School. The home zone description and map are shown below:

Home Zone (Proposed)

All students who live within the home zone described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

The proposed draft Enrolment Zone (EZ) for Pillans Point School includes the entire east side of the northern part of the Ōtūmoetai Peninsula.

The western boundary of the zone is as follows:

In the south, the zone boundary begins at Grange Rd. Starting from (and including) 189 and 210 Grange Rd and heading north, all residential housing on this road, and to the east of this road falls within the EZ. To the west of this road, all residential housing on the following roads stemming from Grange Rd is included: Hillcrest Rd, Pamela Pl, Apollo St, Jules Way, Byron Way, and Vale St.

When travelling west from Grange Rd on Hinewa Rd, all housing on this street is within the school zone up to Ōtūmoetai Rd (1 and 2A-2C Hinewa Rd included). Residential housing on Whitaker St is also included (note that 2 Ridge St on the corner of Whitaker and Ridge St is not within the zone).

From the corner of Hinewa Rd and Ōtūmoetai Rd, Ōtūmoetai Rd forms the western boundary of the Pillans Point School zone. Housing on the east side of the road falls within the zone. The school zone leads north up to the roundabout of Ngatai Rd and Ōtūmoetai Rd. From here the zone boundary corresponds to the railway line heading east. Any housing south of the railway line (i.e. housing on Ngatai Rd east of the roundabout) falls within the zone.

Kulim Park is in the zone and forms the northernmost boundary of the enrolment zone (boundary is between 1 Beach Rd and Kulim Park).



What does this mean for my family?

If you live in the enrolment scheme home zone for Pillans Point School, you will be entitled to enrol your child at the school. This entitlement applies to new students starting school, as well as any primary school aged children currently attending another school in the area.

Families who live outside the enrolment scheme home zone of Pillans Point School do not have entitlement to enrol and could only attend if the Board of Trustees planned to enrol any out of zone students. The enrolment scheme will establish the process for this, and places will only be available if the Board of Trustees considers it has the capacity to allow for this. Further information about whether any out of zone places will be made available will be made later in 2022.

Consultation process and timeline

The Ministry of Education is currently undertaking consultation about the proposed changes to the enrolment scheme. You can have your say by:
