### Queen Charlotte College (287) Enrolment Scheme

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

### Year 7-8 Home Zone

# All Year 7-8 students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Speeds Road and State Highway 1, the home zone follows:

- North along State Highway 1 until Wairau Road
  - Including Station Road,
  - And including all side streets off State Highway 1 between Station Road and Wairau Road
- North-east along Wairau Road until Dorset Street
- North along Dorset Street until Scotland Street
  - West along Scotland Street until Cornwall Street
    - o Including Scotland Street to the west of Cornwall Street,
    - Including West Terrace,
    - And including Webster Place
- North along Cornwall Street until Buller Street
- East along Buller Street until Durham Street
- North along Durham Street until Broadway
  - Including Oxford Street
- East along Broadway until Kent Street
- North along Kent Street until Queen Charlotte Drive
- North-west along Queen Charlotte Drive until and including number 2601 Queen Charlotte Drive
  - o Including Gravesend Place,
  - And including Harbour View Heights
- From 2601 Queen Charlotte Drive jumps to the coastline
- From here travels north-east along the coastline until the south-eastern end of Tumbledown Bay Road
  - Including Arapaoa Island
- North-west along Tumbledown Bay Road until Port Underwood Road

   Including Hakahaka Road
- East along Port Underwood Road until and including number 2217 Port Underwood Road
- From 2217 Port Underwood Road jumps north-west to the end of Garden Terrace
- North-west along Garden Terrace until Devon Street
- North along Devon Street until Canterbury Street
- West along Canterbury Street until Wairau Road

- South-west along Wairau Road until State Highway 1
  - Including all side streets off the south-eastern side of Wairau Road between Canterbury Street and State Highway 1.

#### Year 9-13+ Home Zone

# All Year 9-13+ students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Speeds Road and State Highway 1, the home zone follows:

- North along State Highway 1 until Wairau Road
  - Including Station Road,
  - And including all side streets off State Highway 1 between Station Road and Wairau Road
- North-east along Wairau Road until Dorset Street
- North along Dorset Street until Scotland Street
- West along Scotland Street until Cornwall Street
  - o Including Scotland Street to the west of Cornwall Street,
    - Including West Terrace,
    - And including Webster Place
- North along Cornwall Street until Buller Street
- East along Buller Street until Durham Street
- North along Durham Street until Broadway
  - Including Oxford Street
- East along Broadway until Kent Street
- North along Kent Street until Queen Charlotte Drive
- North-west along Queen Charlotte Drive until and including number 575 Queen Charlotte Drive
  - Including all side streets off Queen Charlotte Drive between Kent Street and 575 Queen Charlotte Drive
- From 575 Queen Charlotte Drive jumps north-east to the coastline
- From here travels south-east following the coastline all the way until Cape Jackson
- From Cape Jackson jumps south-east to the northern point of Arapaoa Island
- South-east following the coastline of Arapaoa Island until on line with the northern point of West Head
- Jumps south-west from Arapaoa Island to the northern point of West Head
- South along the eastern coastline from from West Head until the southeastern end of Tumbledown Bay Road
- North-west along Tumbledown Bay Road until Port Underwood Road
   Including Hakahaka Road
- East along Port Underwood Road until and including number 2217 Port Underwood Road
- From 2217 Port Underwood Road jumps north-west to the end of Garden Terrace
- North-west along Garden Terrace until Devon Street
- North along Devon Street until Canterbury Street
- West along Canterbury Street until Wairau Road

- South-west along Wairau Road until State Highway 1
  - Including all side streets off the south-eastern side of Wairau Road between Canterbury Street and State Highway 1.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

#### **Special Programmes**

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

#### Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the School Board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following enrolment period(s) for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority	This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
Second Priority	will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
Third Priority	will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
Fourth Priority	will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
Fifth Priority	will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
Sixth Priority	will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in any priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with <u>instructions by the Secretary</u>, under <u>Schedule 20</u>, <u>Clause 3 (1)</u> of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.
