

South Wellington Intermediate School Enrolment Scheme

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school. (All numbers are inclusive).

The northern boundary goes along Rugby Street, then along just south of Paterson Street. Addresses on Paterson Street are not in zone. Addresses in Brougham Street, Austin Street and Austin Terrace are also not in zone.

The eastern boundary then runs south to Mein Street, all address on Mein Street are in zone. Addresses on Alexandra Road are not in zone. The zone continues to run south to Constable Street. Corunna Avenue, Douro Avenue, Seddon Terrace and Constable Street are in zone. Addresses on Crawford Road are not in zone. The zone continues to run south to Manchester Street. Paeroa Street, Colville Street, Manchester Terrace, Antico Street and Caprera Street are in zone. The zone then runs down Sutherland Road, all addresses on Sutherland Road are in zone. The zone then runs along Queens Drive. Addresses 256 – 500 even and 249 – 381 odd Queens Drive are in zone.

The southern boundary runs along the South Coast including Houghton Bay, Island Bay and Owhiro Bay. All addresses on Owhiro Bay Parade are in zone.

The western boundary includes all of Happy Valley Road. Addresses on Ohiro Road is not in zone. The zone runs along Quebec Street, all dead-end streets off Quebec Street are in zone including Vancouver Street. The scheme continues along The Ridgeway and then onto Mills Road. Addresses in Washington Avenue are not in zone. The scheme then runs onto and along Pearce Street. All addresses in Pearce Street are in zone. The scheme then continues North to Wallace Street. Addresses on Hutchison Road are in zone. Addresses 46 – 132 even and 47 – 149 odd Wallace Street are in zone. Addresses on Wright Street are not in zone. Addresses 50 – 192 even and 45 – 205 odd Tasman Street are in zone. The scheme the runs back along Rugby Street.

Where a property has two or more entrances on different streets, or where the actual address of a property is in dispute, only the rateable address as recognised by the local City Council will be considered to determine if the property is in or out of zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the order of priority specified in the Education and Training Act 2020.

One calendar month before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period subsequent to the first, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority This priority is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.

Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
