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# Waitoriki School (2262)

## Zone Description

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### Home Zone

Effective from (date to be added)

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20 of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

**All students who live within the home zone described below and/or shown on the attached map shall be entitled to enrol at the school. Both sides of the road are included unless otherwise stated.**

- 1. The zone begins at the southern boundary of 479 Wortley Road and follows the southern boundary of 479 Wortley Road and the northern boundary of 1158 and 1126 Richmond Road until they intercept with Richmond Road.*
- 2. The zone then turns left and proceeds north on Richmond Road until the northern boundary of 1069 Richmond Road.*
- 3. The zone then follows the northern boundary of 1069 Richmond Road until it reaches its western point.*
- 4. From the western most point of 1069 Richmond Road, the zone proceeds in a straight line to the intersection point of Lincoln Road and York Road. Properties number off Kelly Road are not in zone.*
- 5. At the intersection of York Road and Lincoln Road, the zone turns left and heads north to the end of York Road.*
- 6. The zone then returns along York Road to the intersection of York Road and Lincoln Road. Properties number off Clarke Road are not in zone.*
- 7. The zone proceeds south on Lincoln Road until 3 Lincoln Road. All properties number off Lincoln East Road are in zone.*
- 8. The zone then returns on Lincoln Road until the intersection of Lincoln Road and Wortley Road.*
- 9. The zone then turns left and follows Wortley Road until the southern boundary of 479 Wortley Road. Properties on Davis Road are not in zone.*

## **In-Zone Enrolments**

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the school board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

## **Out of Zone Enrolments**

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The school board will publish this information by notice on the school website, and in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment for each zone will be processed in the following order of priority, according to legislation:

**First Priority**     *This priority category is not applicable to this school.*

**Second Priority**     will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

**Third Priority**     will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

**Fourth Priority**     will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

**Fifth Priority**     will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

**Sixth Priority**     will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by media suitable to the area served by the school.

**Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.**
